### ADVERBS

An adverb describes a verb, an adjective or another adverb. It tells us how, where, when, how much and with what frequency.

The **adverbs of manner** describe **how** people do things.

She walks *slowly*. The dog barks *noisily*.

On the other hand, adjectives describe nouns.

She is *slow*. The dog is *noisy*.

kind slow bad	kindly slowly badly	Add -ly
careful beautiful	carefully beautifully	Add -ly
happy noisy easy	happily noisily easily	-y changes to -i and then add -ly
responsible	responsibly	-ble changes - bly
good	well	Irregular. The adverb changes.
hard fast	hard fast	Irregular No change.

## Adverbs of manner

**Already, quickly, and always** are different kinds of adverbs. They give information about time, manner and frequency.

Adjectives describe nouns (things and people).  
*She has a quiet voice.*  
*It's a noisy dog.*



They often answer questions with **What ... ?**

Adverbs of manner describe how people do things.  
*She speaks quietly. The dog barks noisily.*  
They often answer questions with **How ... ?**

Most adjectives change to adverbs of manner like this.

Most regular adjectives	Adjectives ending in -y	Adjectives ending in -ble
+ ly	-ily	-bly
nice → nicely	angry → angrily	comfortable → comfortably

There are some irregular adverbs of manner.

good → well  
He's a good swimmer. → He swims well.  
fast → fast  
She's a fast runner. → She runs fast.  
hard → hard  
They're hard workers. → They work hard.

We usually use adverbs after verbs.  
*She sings beautifully.*

However, we use adjectives after the verbs **be, seem, become, get, look, feel, taste, smell and sound.**  
*Her voice sounds beautiful.*  
*You'll get hungry.*
